Anne comes out of a movement to make media that helps create opportunity for social change. She has made documentary films (always with limited resources) since the 1970¹s and was associate director and assistant camerawoman for HARLAN COUNTY, USA. She is associated with Appalshop in Whitesburg, Kentucky and currently works in Austin, Texas as a Professor of Practice at UT Austin.
